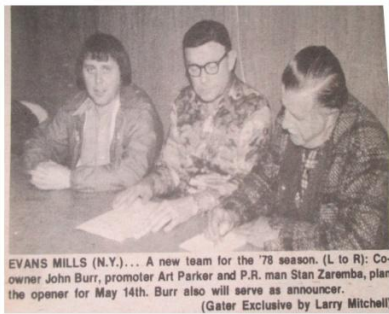
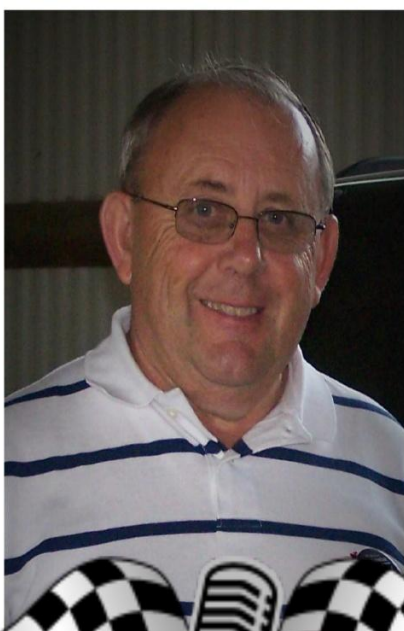

2025 EMRP Season in Review

The 2025 season at the Evans Mills Raceway Park was nothing short of spectacular! From high-octane racing to heartwarming community events, EMRP delivered an action-packed calendar that had fans on the edge of their seats all summer long.

Opening Night roared to life with STOP DWI New York, presenting the kickoff. New faces filled nearly every division, while the annual Jake's Automotive Small Block Supermodifieds set the pace. Drivers like Chuck Meyer, Joe Papin, Mike Cole, and Justin Burns put on a show with feature wins. The season's first thrill came in the INEX Legends, where Joel Hall snatched a dramatic late-race victory, setting the tone for what was to come.

Legends Night upped the ante with the 3rd Annual Zeigler '67 Memorial and a National Qualifier for Christmas Fuel Service INEX Legends. Fans cheered as Joe Papin led Modifieds to victory, Dalton Rombough topped the Legends qualifier, and Tyler Papin claimed the Pro Late Model win after a tense battle with Chuck Meyer. Mike Cole and Justin Burns kept the excitement alive in Sport Compacts and Thunderstocks.

The annual Relay for Life of the North Country celebrated their 40th anniversary nationally by hosting the event at EMRP for the first time that featured a touching luminaria ceremony, themed laps, live music, prizes, and hospitality in the Survivors tent.

June was packed with community-themed events that brought families and fans closer to the action. CDL Drivers Appreciation Night honored the hardworking men and women of the road, while Champlain Valley Equipment Agriculture Appreciation Night celebrated local farms with tractors, raffles, and spectacular racing. Dylan Bancroft secured his first Pro Late Model victory, Brayton Malbeuf returned to the Thousand Island Bait Store victory lane, and Tony Pettinelli joined the Classic Asphalt Modified shows with a winning machine.

The Race of Champions Tour Modifieds Rocket 76er was a high-speed spectacle. Matt Hirschman captured the ROC feature again over Andy Jankowiak, while Joe Papin dominated Modifieds for his 10th career victory. Rookies Josh Oomen(Legends) and Levi Goodale(Thunderstocks) kept the excitement high as they both snagged their first career wins

Christmas Miracle Night turned the track into a winter wonderland, with over 100 children going home with a new gift donated by race teams. The Kinney Drugs Modifieds ran twin-25 lap features. Jeff Pringle and Tony Pettinelli would go on to win.

Military Appreciation Night honored our heroes with patriotic tributes. On track, the action didn't disappoint: Joey Clark and Anthony St. Mary Jr. would add their names to the list of first-time winners in 2025. Jared Gilson would keep the points race tight with Justin Burns and Colby Goodale.

The 4-Banger Nationals brought intense, wheel-to-wheel competition thrilling fans with a four-car battle on the last lap that Mike Greenfield survived to score the Sport Compacts win. Levi Goodale would charge to the front of the field to score the Thunderstocks win. Taylor Caprara, visitor Dan Side, Chuck Meyer, and Aaron Pugh would close out the night with wins.

The 2X Monster Trucks Live Tour returned for their annual double header weekend. New truck Roar'n Rex and returning truck Jekyll & Hyde showed off in freestyle while Bounty Hunter, Scarlet Bandit, and Shark Bite dominated the evening. Fans spent the day getting rides in Monster Trucks, capturing autographs, and enjoying the festivities.

Valvoline Autograph Night drew hundreds of first-time fans for a jam-packed evening featuring daring stunts by Crash Test Carter. Feature winners included Tony Pettinelli, Joel Hall, Jeff Pringle, Mike Greenfield, Justin Burns, and Chuck Meyer, each leaving their mark on the track.

A special Nicole Berry-Garnsey Night combined health, wellness, and family fun with games, giveaways, and the first-ever Kinney Drugs Modifieds Pit Crew Clash presented by BG Fab. Fans cheered for creative competitions while racing delivered non-stop excitement with victories from Mark Barker, Tim Greenfield, Josh Oomen, Andre Roggie, and Colby Goodale. Anthony Pettinelli would win the Pit Crew Clash, and Andre Roggie would win best theme, with his three daughters performing the pit stop.

First Responders Night, presented by S&R Automotive, was a highlight of the year. The inaugural Memorial Stair Climb honored fallen heroes, while more than 25 agencies showcased emergency vehicles on the midway. Race fans watched in awe as box car races, a grudge match between Crash Test Carter and Eric Doolittle, and feature wins from Jared Gilson, Chuck Meyer, Dalton Rombough, and Joe Papin kept the energy high, even as a heavy rain ended the night early.

King of the Mills Night would conclude the season with Mike Greenfield winning both Sport Compact features. Taylor Caprara, Josh Oomen, Justin Burns would also win while Rylee Gill would win the final Pro Late Model race at EMRP. Division Champions Papin, Hall, Meyer, Cole, and Burns would have a champagne party on the front stretch at the end of the night.

Spectator Drag races would occur four times with Brendan Fone, Dan Estal, and Tim Keyes winning competitions in the double-elimination format.

The 2025 season at EMRP was a masterclass in excitement, community spirit, and motorsport excellence. From heart-pounding finishes to family-centered events, fans witnessed unforgettable moments week after week. With this level of action, 2026 is already shaping up to be an even bigger, faster, and louder season at Evans Mills Raceway Park!

2025 ISMA/MSS Season in Review

The ISMA MSS Supermodified series enters the Evans Mills Raceway Park for the third consecutive year to determine their points champion before their final non-points event at Caraway Speedway. The battle for the championship is as close as ever with only 188 points separating the top six drivers. Let's look at the events that led to this exciting weekend.

Trent Stephens dominated the ISMA-MSS Delaware 50 Friday night at Delaware Speedway, driving to a commanding first win of the 2025 season and his first triumph at the half-mile Canadian oval. Starting fourth, Stephens quickly advanced past Moe Lilje for second on lap 4 and overtook pole-sitter Mike Ordway Jr. six laps later, building a comfortable lead while navigating lapped traffic with ease. Mike McVetta surged to third, Kyle Edwards made a late charge to fourth, and hometown favorite Mark Sammut thrilled fans by muscling into the top five. A lone caution on lap 33 shuffled the leaders, but Stephens' decision to restart on the outside allowed him to maintain control and cruise to the checkered flag. Tyler Shullick set a new track record in qualifying but recovered from a heat crash to finish ninth. The race marked ISMA-MSS's first Canadian appearance since 2019, and Stephens credited his team, sponsors, and fans for helping deliver a flawless performance.

Mike Ordway Jr. stole the show at the ISMA-MSS Lancaster 50 Saturday night at Lancaster Motorplex, storming from an eighth-place starting spot to capture his 15th career series win and first of 2025. Ordway methodically carved through the field, passing top competitors including Dave Danzer, Mark Sammut, and Mike McVetta before executing a spectacular inside pass on lap 39 threading past McVetta, leader Tyler Shullick, and a lapped car in one daring move to take command. From there, Ordway cruised to the checkered flag while Shullick and McVetta battled behind him. Otto Sitterly set a new track record in qualifying but suffered an early spin, and Andy Jankowski earned some winged supermodified experience at his home track. The race marked ISMA-MSS's first return to Lancaster since 2018, featuring 22 supermodifieds and thrilling on-track action.

Otto Sitterly captured a third victory in the ISMA-MSS Winged Supermodified 50 at Oswego Speedway Saturday night, earning his 10th career series win and first of 2025. Starting fourth, Sitterly worked past early leaders Michael Muldoon Jr. and Kyle Edwards, taking second by lap 6 before making a decisive inside pass on lap 26 in Turn 2 to seize the lead. Mike McVetta staged a late-race charge to second, while Muldoon finished third and Mike Ordway Jr. fourth. The race featured only one caution for a spinning Kyle Hutchinson and intense battles through a 20-car field. Sitterly credited his late-race strategy and crew support for a flawless performance at Oswego.

Kyle Edwards captured his first win of the 2025 ISMA-MSS season Friday night at Berlin Raceway, taking the Great Lakes Classic 40 for his fifth career series victory. Starting third, Edwards steadily advanced past early leaders Rich Reid and Ryan Zitzka, taking the lead on a lap 11 restart after Mike Ordway Jr. retired with mechanical issues. Edwards held off Josh Sokolic, Tyler Shullick, Otto Sitterly, and Mike McVetta through multiple cautions, choosing the inside lane on a key restart to maintain his advantage. Despite early retirements from Moe Lilje, Tyler Thompson, and Grant Thormeier, Edwards skillfully navigated lapped traffic to claim a dominant win and his third career Berlin Raceway victory.

For the second consecutive year, Ohio's Mike McVetta dominated Berlin Raceway, capturing Night 2's 75-lap Great Lakes Classic feature and a \$10,000 payday. Starting fourth, McVetta methodically moved into the top five by lap 13 and applied late-race pressure on early leader Jeff Abold. Executing a decisive outside pass around Abold, who then spun on Turn 4, McVetta took the lead for good. Navigating lap traffic and fending off challenges from Josh Sokolic, Kyle Edwards, and Tyler Shullick, McVetta finished 14.5 seconds ahead to secure both the win and the series points lead. Abold recovered to second, while Sokolic, Edwards, and Shullick completed the top five in a 15-car field marked by spins from Otto Sitterly and Mark Sammut.

Mike Lichte claimed his second consecutive Friday Hy-Miler Fast 40 victory at Sandusky Speedway, outgunning Mark Sammut on a dramatic lap 16 double-file restart. Starting sixth, Lichte advanced past Trent Stephens, AJ Lesiecki, and Michael Barnes before seizing the lead on the restart following Otto Sitterly's spin. Controlling the race through multiple cautions, Lichte fended off Sammut, Tyler Shullick, Johnny Benson Jr., and Kyle Edwards to cross the finish line first, earning the Hard Charger Award and setting the stage for Saturday's Hy-Miler Nationals 100.

Dave Shullick Jr. captured his fifth career Hy-Miler Nationals 100 victory at Sandusky Speedway, giving Osetek Racing Technologies its first win in the prestigious 100-lapper. After early leader Michael Barnes dominated until a broken torque arm bracket on lap 65 forced him out, Shullick seized the lead from Mike Ordway Jr. and steadily pulled away. Multiple late-race cautions tested the field, but Shullick held off Friday winner Mike Lichty and Tyler Shullick on the final restart to secure the win. Mark Sammut, Johnny Benson Jr., and Kyle Edwards rounded out the top five, with Shullick tying his father for five career Hy-Miler wins.

Mike Ordway Jr. became the first repeat winner of the 2025 ISMA-MSS season, taking the Ollie Silva Mid-Summer Classic 75 at Lee USA Speedway. Starting third, Ordway overtook early leader Trent Stephens on lap 15 and opened a gap over a competitive field including Kyle Edwards, Tyler Shullick, and Jeffrey Battle. Multiple cautions, mechanical issues, and a late red-flag refuel added drama, while Mike McVetta briefly claimed the lead before electrical issues ended his night. Ordway held off Tyler Shullick to cross the finish line 2.087 seconds ahead, with Battle third, Mark Sammut fourth, and Edwards fifth. The win, worth \$6,000 plus a \$3,000 bonus, marked his second of the season and second career triumph at Lee USA.

Now the ISMA MSS Supermodifieds take center stage at the 3/8th mile oval in the 1,000 islands region. The first installment of the Championship 100 saw Jeff Abold score the feature win after completing a bold three-wide pass on the outside of the former leader and a lapped car. Mike McVetta would score the Driver and Owner's championship that night. The 2024 edition was dominated by Otto Sitterly winning the Fast 40 on Friday night, the Championship 100, and the Driver's Championship while holding off an impressive Josh Sokolic. John Nicotra was crowned the Owner's Champion in 2024.

The Kevin Ward Jr. Legacy Race is a memorial event for the Christman Fuel Service INEX Legends division at the Evans Mills Raceway Park. 2025 is the first year the memorial race has supported this INEX Legends cars after a history of being the lone asphalt event for the Empire Super Sprints. Ward family and partners Westward Painting Co. and Herring Log Home Restoration have graciously supported the purse for INEX competitors.

Kevin Ward Jr.'s legacy lives on through this event in which his nephew Landen Herring and family will be competing in. The 40-lap feature is also a second National Qualifier for INEX at The Mills in 2025. INEX Legend Car drivers can earn points towards a national ranking system by competing in sanctioned races at home tracks, or regional events. Drivers can earn the status of state champion,

and National Champion. INEX national points are divided into four groups based on age and performance; Young Lions, Semi-Pro, Pro, and Masters. National Qualifier races give the top finishing drivers in each of the four divisions an automatic starting spot in the National Championship event which is held at The Bullring at Las Vegas Motor Speedway in 2025.

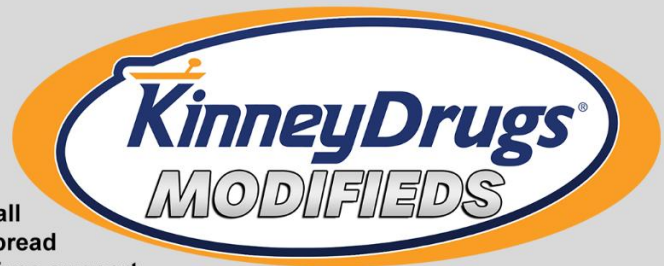

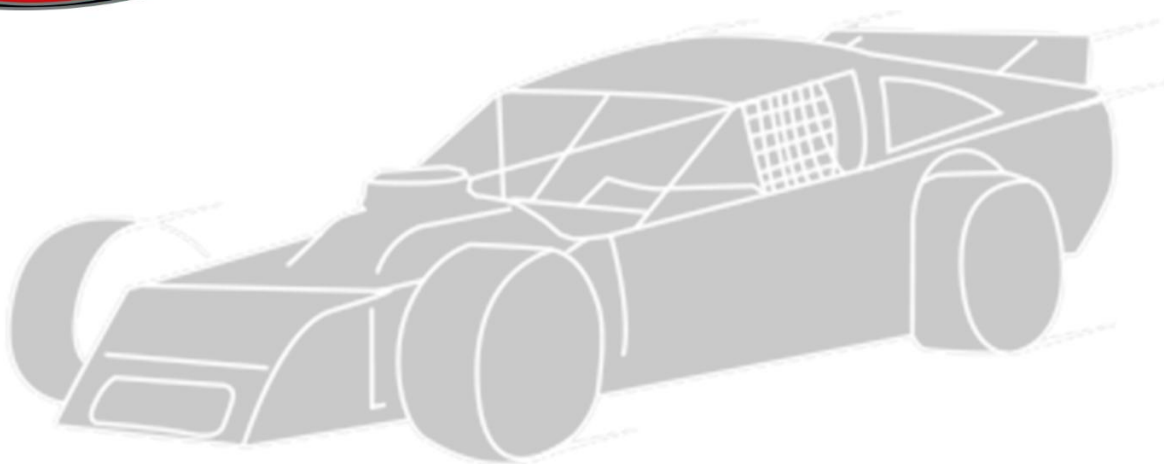
